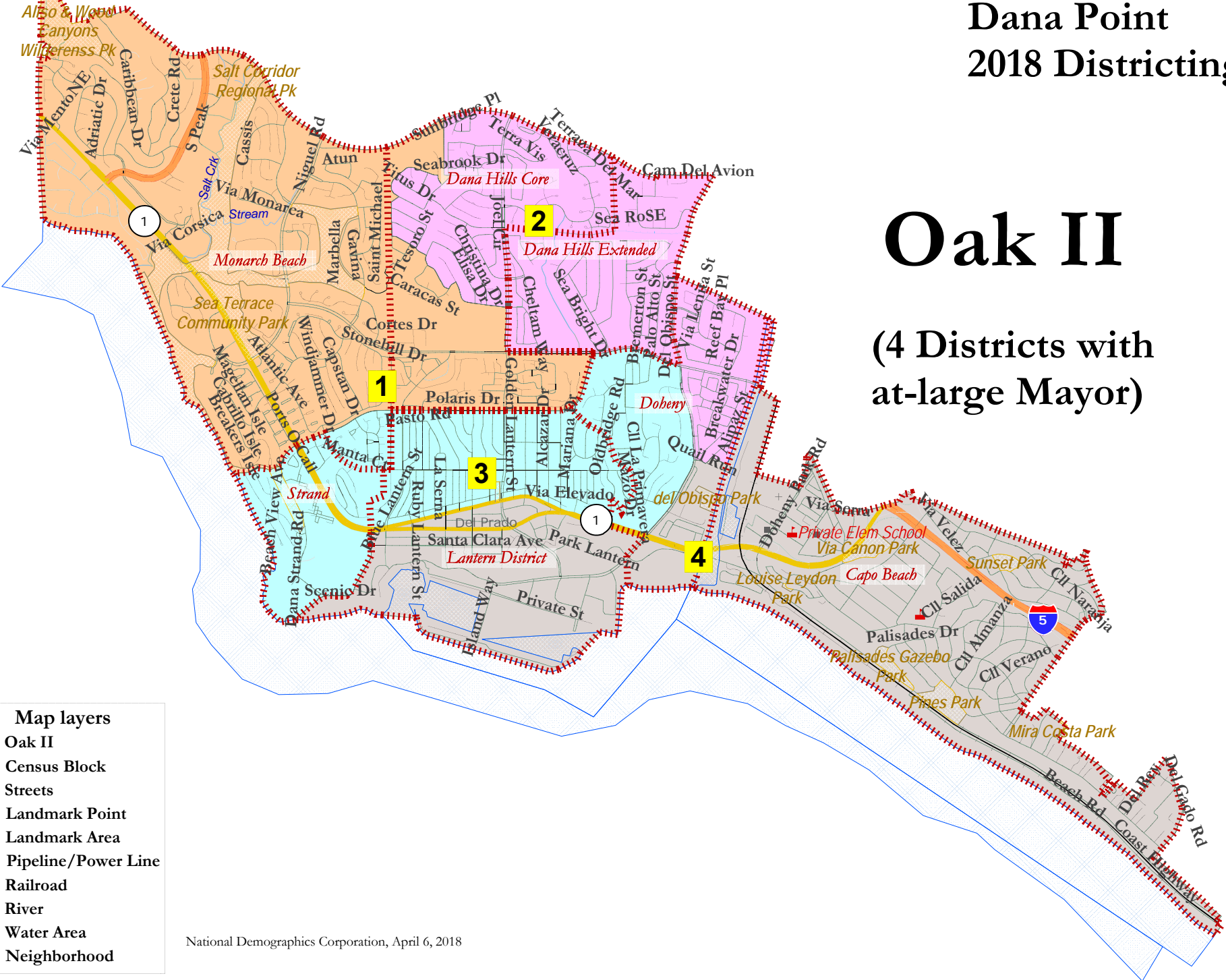


Dana Point 2018 Districting
