Dana Point Announces Second Annual Community Calendar Photo Contest

Dana Point, CA (July 17, 2018) -- The City of Dana Point has kicked off its second annual photo contest. Twelve to 15 winning entries will be featured in the City's Annual Community Calendar for 2019. The City is looking for historic photos that celebrate the City's inception 29 years ago. Residents and businesses are encouraged to look through their albums to help tell the City's story. Photos can be provided in a digital format or printed images can be dropped off at the City to have them scanned and returned. Photos can also be submitted through social media using #picturedanapoint or emailed to picture@danapoint.org.

The deadline for submission is Labor Day, September 3, 2018. Contest rules are as follows:

- Historical photos must have been taken before 1989
- All photos must have been taken in Dana Point
- Submit descriptions, including year, location, and photo contributor
- All of the selected winning images must be scanned as a tiff file for quality purposes, or the City can also scan original images and return to the resident or business
- There is no limit to number of submissions

Winners will be announced online and the City will contact each winner. Images will be selected for each of the 12 calendar months, as well as featured on the cover and back of the calendar.

This new edition will be the 13th annual Community Calendar of Dana Point. Each year the calendars are given out around the community for free. Calendars can also be ordered through the City. The Dana Point calendar has become a favorite part of the City's culture, and is an exciting way to show how much local residents and businesses love their City.
