On June 4, 2018 at 12 noon, a Dana Point Trolley with a newly-installed surfboard and stand-up paddleboard rack will be parked in front of Killer Dana featuring surfboards from Infinity, Hobie, Killer Dana, Girl in the Curl and Jack's.

Dana Point Trolley Now Features Surfboard and Stand-Up Paddleboard Racks

Dana Point, CA (June 4, 2018) -- Capitalizing on the most expansive Dana Point Trolley Route to date, the City of Dana Point has now added racks for surfboards and stand-up paddleboards to the five trolleys set to roll on June 8.

In a community such as Dana Point, where recreation on the water is a way of life, these racks provide an opportunity to use the trolley to get to the beach with surf equipment in tow. Eight boards can fit on each trolley however; boards less than five feet must be taken onto the trolley.

"The City is stoked to offer surfboard racks as part of the trolley program. It's another way we are working to provide innovative ways for our residents and visitors to get around the City. And it just might save Dana Point moms some trips dropping off or picking up sandy kids and boards at the beach," said Dana Point City Manager Mark Denny.

The Dana Point Trolley program begins on June 8, 2018 and extends through September 3, 2018. Total cost to the City to install the racks was covered by a grant. Installation included custom surfboard and stand-up paddleboard racks, trolley hitch and receiver, assembly and installation for a total of \$22,133 for all five trolleys to be outfitted.

For those who don't own a surfboard or stand-up paddleboard, the public is encouraged to rent boards from one of Dana Point's fine local surf shops and hop on the trolley to get to and from the beach. Rental shops are located near trolley stops 3, 4, 15, 20 and 21.
