Kaylani Kristjanson (H2O Protectors Club) provided a handout to Council, spoke regarding ocean pollution, and requested that her proposed beach cleanup solution be added to an upcoming agenda. Mayor Gabbard invited Ms. Kristjanson to meet with him and the OC Parks Commission to discuss her proposed idea.

Damian Hickman and Ryan Hickman (Recycle from Home) spoke regarding Recycle from Home, provided information about its recycling efforts, and encouraged the Council to join the program.

Robert Chavez (Dana Point) spoke regarding recycling efforts and encouraged the Council to join the Recycle from Home program.

Anthony Small (Dana Point Art & Culture Ambassador) thanked City Staff for their efforts on the Día de los Muertos event and shared a quote from Louie Perez of the band Los Lobos. He requested City support for the documentary featuring the band Native Sons, through the producing nonprofit, The Gotham.

Council Member Villar asked Kelly Reenders, City Manager, to meet with Anthony Small regarding the request.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

14. APPEAL OF PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVAL OF VARIANCE 25-0001 AND SITE DEVELOPMENT PERMIT SDP25-0010 TO ALLOW THE DEVELOPMENT OF A THREE-STORY, SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLING AT 33911 CALLE LA PRIMAVERA

Alyssa Gonzalez, Senior Planner, provided a Staff Report and answered Council questions.

Mayor Gabbard opened the Public Hearing at 6:45 P.M.

Randy Moore (Appellant) spoke regarding the height variance and view obstruction and presented photographs to illustrate his testimony. Clifford Neiman, Registered Architect, spoke regarding height variances and potential compromise options.

Robert Digruccio (Appellant) spoke regarding the height variance and view obstruction and presented photographs of balloon testing to illustrate his testimony. He requested that modifications be made to the plans so the structure conforms to the integrity of the neighborhood.

Brendan Corbett (Appellant) read a statement submitted by his father, Tim Corbett, and requested compromise and modifications to have the structure better fit the identity of the neighborhood.

James Carlson (Project Architect) referred to Mr. Moore's photos of the stakes and balloons, noting that they appear different due to the sloping of the project site. He also explained the project design process and the timeline with the City and answered Council questions.

Doug Schoon (Dana Point) spoke regarding the homes built below the proposed structure and potential land-related impacts the new structure may cause. He recommended that the structure design be scaled back to better suit the environment and answered Council questions.

Gerard Delio (Dana Point) spoke regarding view obstruction and recommended that modifications be made to the current building plans.

Clifford Neiman provided rebuttal testimony regarding measurement discrepancies and stated that the structure does not follow the usual step pattern for slopes.

Robert Digruccio (Appellant) provided rebuttal testimony regarding the placement of the stakes and stated the wind interference prevented the balloon from giving a proper perspective of the proposed height.

James Carlson denied the rebuttal opportunity.

Mayor Gabbard closed the Public Hearing at 7:27 P.M.

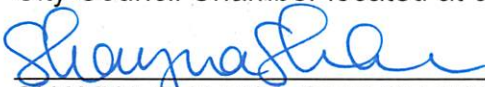
